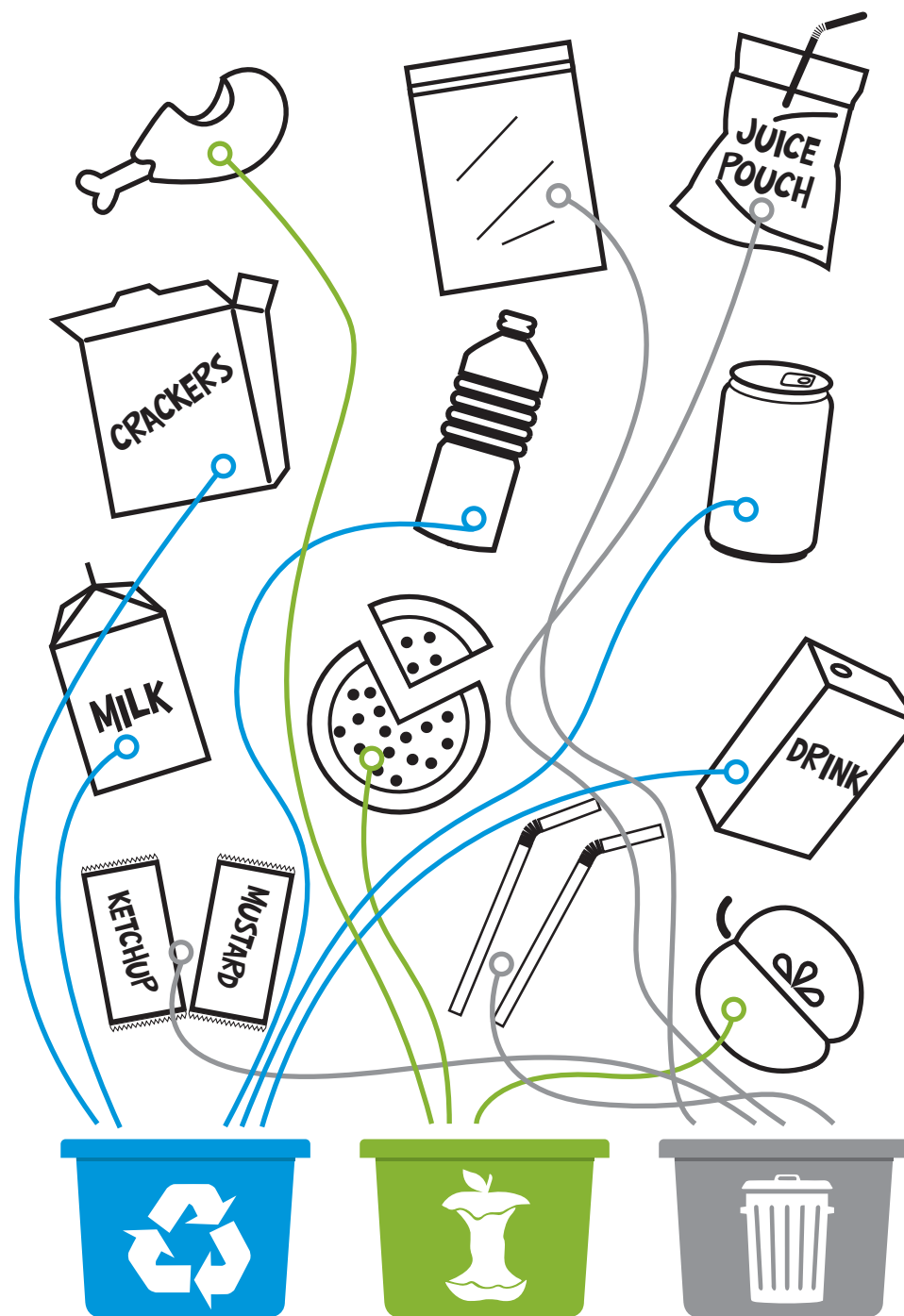

7. THE TRASH BIN IS USED FOR ITEMS LIKE CHIP BAGS AND CANDY WRAPPERS.
8. PLASTIC BOTTLES CAN BE RECYCLED, BUT PLASTIC SANDWICH BAGS BELONG IN THE TRASH.

**CAFETERIA CLEANUP**

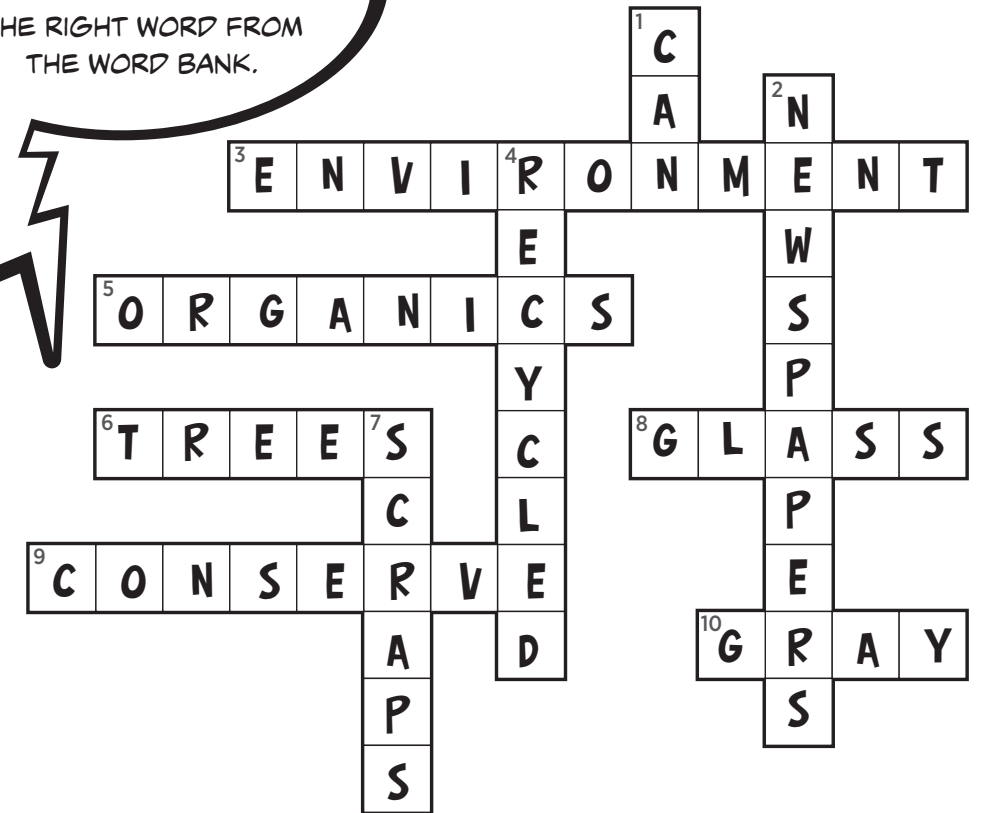
COLOR AND SORT THESE COMMON CAFETERIA ITEMS.
